What is BISO?

Business Information Security Office or Officer

The BISO is an emerging role that acts as a liaison between an organization's business units and its cybersecurity function.

BISOs must become familiar with the businesses they support and understand the overall business's strategic roadmap. They then align those with the cybersecurity function's priorities and initiatives, advancing the information security posture across the organization and, essentially, filling the gap between business operations and cybersecurity program management.






