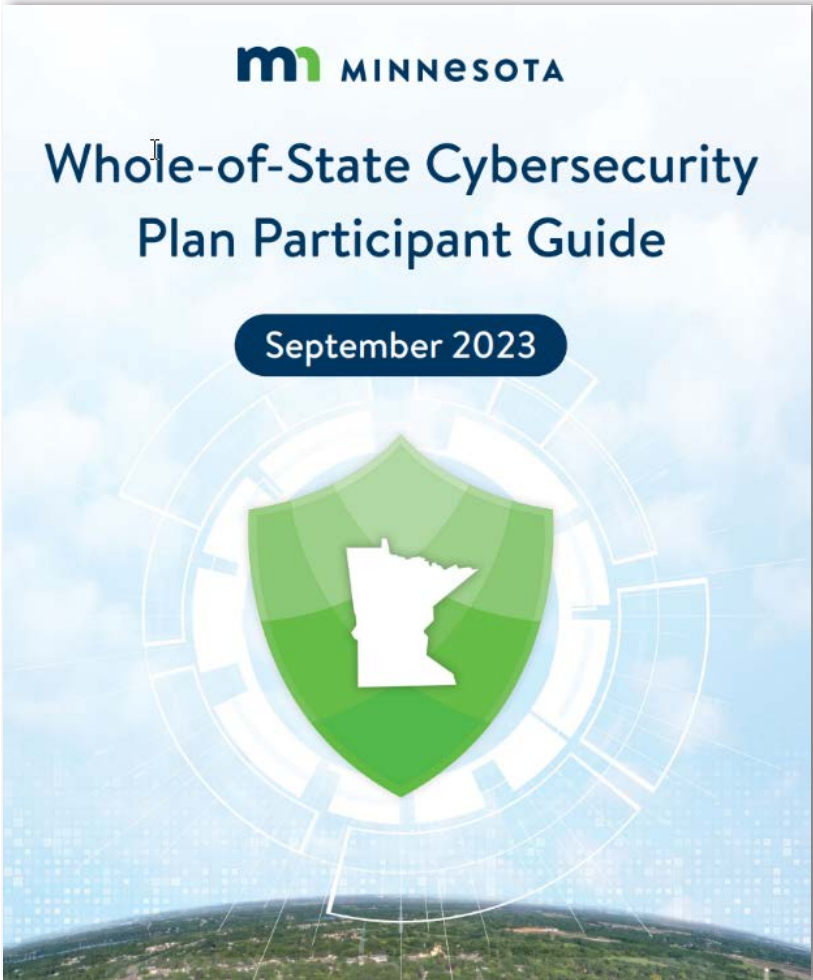

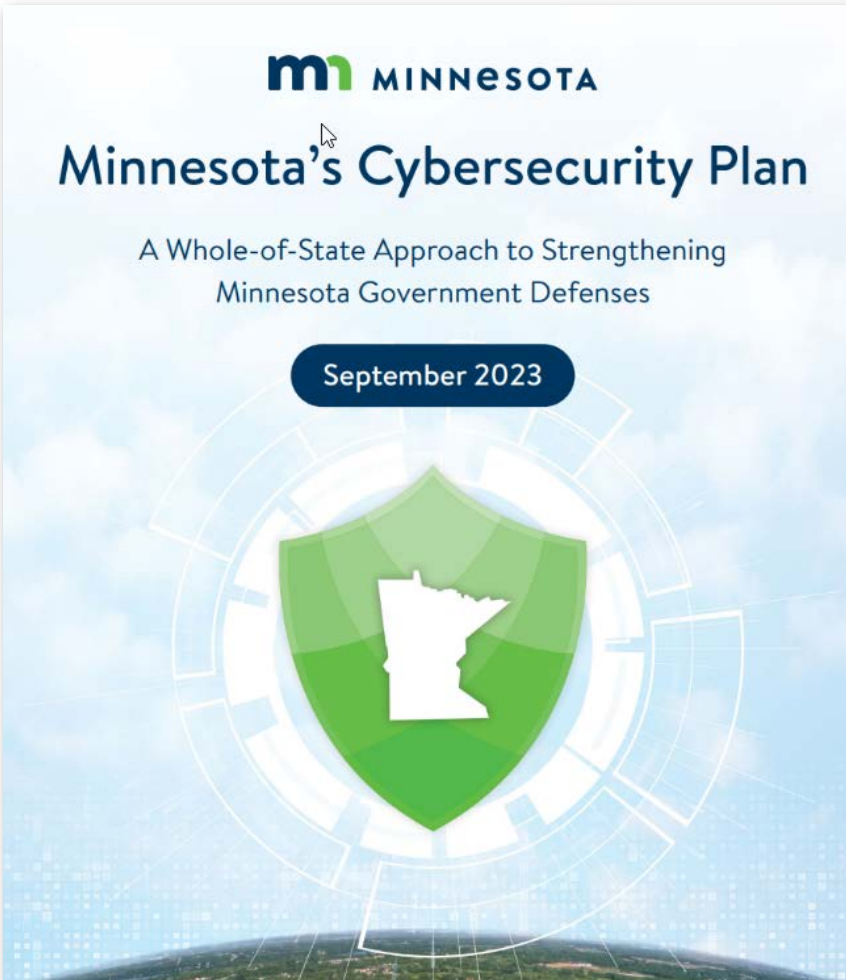

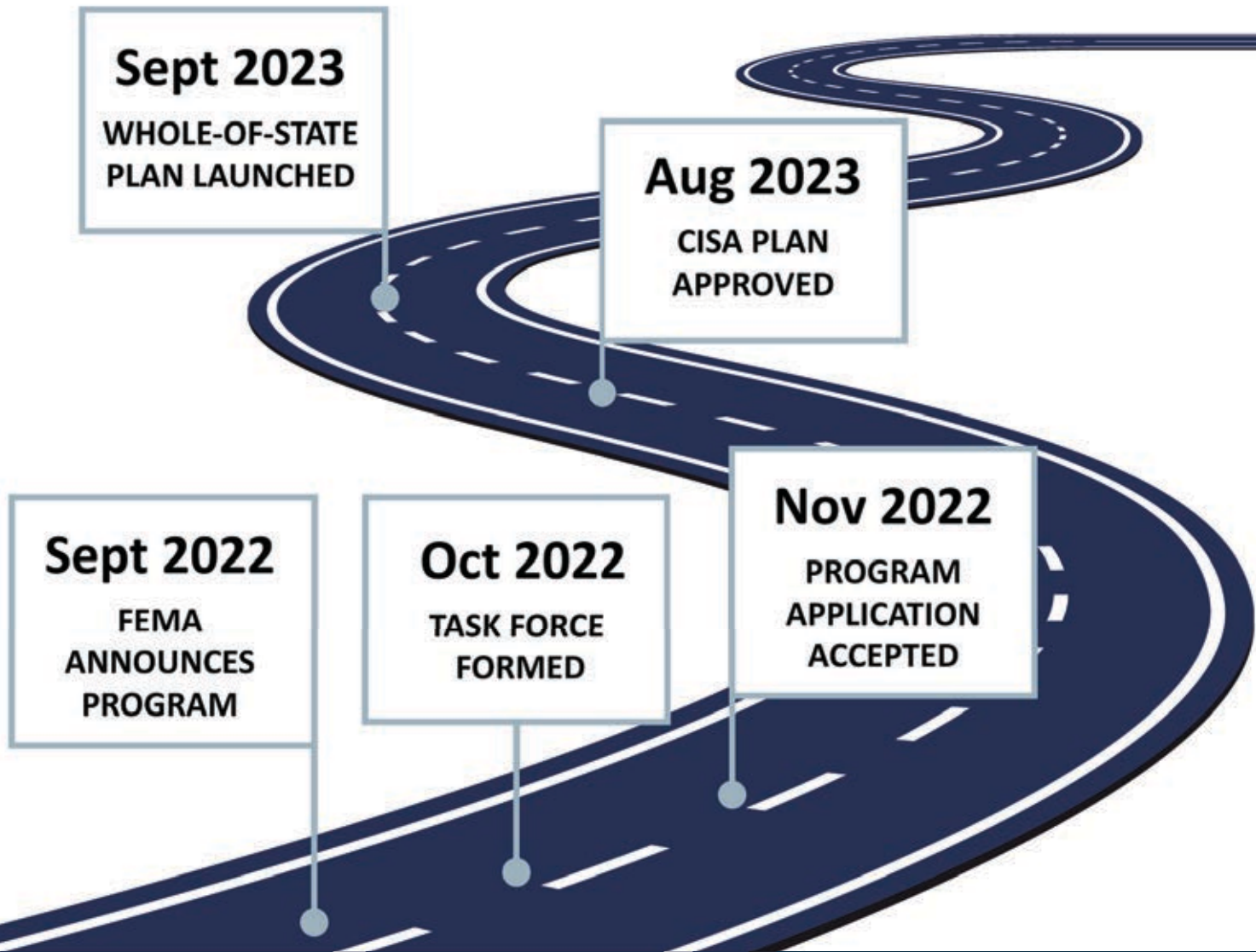

What entities can participate?

All state and local government entities are eligible to participate in the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP).

> **This grant program opens up shared cybersecurity solutions, tools and funding to entities across Minnesota, including:**

- County, municipality, city, town, township, local public authority
- Rural community, unincorporated town or village, or other public entity
- School district, special district, intrastate district
- Authorized Tribal governments and organizations
- Council of governments, regional or interstate government entity, or agency or instrumentality of a local government
